In-N-Out Cover to Cover Reading Program

The In-N-Out Cover to Cover reading program is back! Children will receive a certificate for one free hamburger or cheeseburger for every five books read, with up to three certificates available! Children ages 4 to 12 with a valid Cerritos Library card and a Beanstack account are eligible to participate. If a child cannot read independently, a parent or guardian may read to them. Participants will log their reading through the Beanstack app or website. For every five books logged, a digital badge will be earned. Each badge will turn from black-and-white to color once the reading goal is met. When children earn a badge, they qualify for a Cover to Cover Achievement Award certificate, which can be redeemed for an In-N-Out hamburger or cheeseburger. Participants may earn up to three badges and receive a maximum of three certificates (limited to one per week), while supplies last. The Cover to Cover Reading Program begins on Monday, October 6 and runs through Monday, November 17.




VOX Books and Wonderbooks

The Cerritos Library is pleased to offer a limited selection of VOX Books and Wonderbooks for borrowing. These children's read-aloud books feature an integrated, permanent audiobook player, allowing children to listen to the narration while reading the printed text. Both formats are well-suited for children developing reading skills and comprehension, providing hands-free listening experience without the need for additional devices. These audio-enabled books are available on the new books shelf in the children's library.

Each item may be borrowed for three weeks, with a \$1.00 late fee for overdue returns per item per day. Patrons must check out and return these items at the circulation desk. Only one audio-enabled book may be checked out per library card and are not renewable. Items can be requested at the Children's Help Desk and held at the circulation desk for up to three days.
